Position Title: Equipment Operator

Reports to: Maintenance Supervisor

Job Description: The Equipment Operator will work with other employees on the Water Distribution staff to quickly carry out assigned work orders that may include; maintenance of equipment, repairs to water mains, installation or relocation of water services and construction of new water mains. In addition, the Equipment Operator is responsible for resolving problems that may affect the delivery of water services to customers during regularly schedule business day; which is Monday thru Friday (8:00am to 4:00pm EST). A rotating on-call schedule is required for this position. The Equipment Operator will follow communication procedures, guidelines, policies and other duties as assigned.

Primary Position Requirements:

- Ability to safely and effectively operate a variety of equipment
- Physical demand requirements are for very heavy work
- Ability to evaluate situations and make decisions
- Knowledge of occupational hazards and safety precautions
- Familiarity with construction and maintenance type work
- Customer service and ability to adapt and respond to changing situations
- Ability to prioritize and manage time effectively

Experience: Proficient operating dump trucks, excavators, skid steer loaders, and backhoes in a new construction and or maintenance environment. Utility owns both joystick and foot swing control equipment.

Education: High school diploma or equivalent.

Certifications & Licenses: Preference for TN Water Distribution license and Class A CDL. Candidate must attain CDL certification within 90 days of hire.
